Setting sail from the picturesque Victoria Harbour, our journey begins as we cruise downstream along the Yarra River, meandering through the bustling Port of Melbourne.

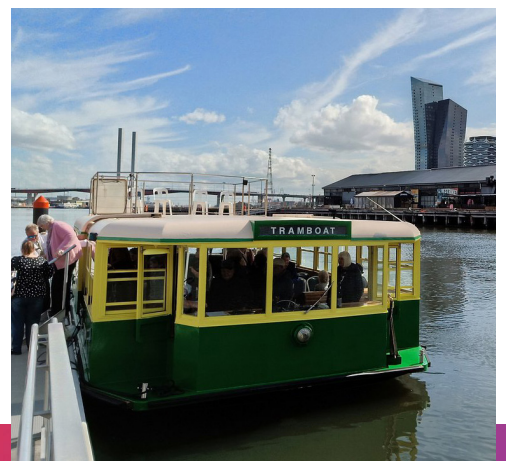
